Former Deputy Mayor Shu of the New Taipei City

Government in violation of the Anticorruption Act

Mr. Hsu, while serving as deputy mayor of the New Taipei City Government from Dec. 25, 2010 to Jun. 30, 2014, was chairman of the Urban Renewal Committee and also vice chairman of the Urban Planning Committee (later resuming as chairman from Jan. 1, 2012 to Jun. 30, 2014). He presided over the Committees, and was in charge of examining and making policies on the urban renewal and planning of New Taipei City.

When he was examining the “Major Plan to Reform DanShui (X area)” and “Detailed Plans of DanShui (X area) Reform” proposed by Yuan Y Construction Company, he got acquainted with the company’s president and vice manager via his friend, Mr. Chou. Then he accepted numerous treats and eventually millions NT dollars from the company in exchange of loosening requirements on retract of the base ground and on limitation of height of the plans. so as to help the company get approvals from the government. His behaviors violate §5I③ and §11 of the Anticorruption Act.

Prosecutor Tsai of the Anticorruption Division in this Office directed officers from the Anticorruption Office of the Ministry of Justice today to search the Company and its top managers with nine search warrants, and will further interrogate suspects and

witnesses to make clear relevant facts of this case.
