Taipei District Prosecutors Office Held The Forum of The Legal Reform
The newly appointed Chief Prosecutor of Taipei District Prosecutors Office, Tsai
Pi-Yu, who conducted inspection on the work of each department right after she was
on board. In addition, considering that justice is for the people, she learned how
people view and think of prosecutor's duty in the 2015 Judicial Reform Public Forum
held jointly by the Taipei District Prosecutors Office and Daan District office in the
afternoon on 22th June. Chief Prosecutor Tsai led 4 Head Prosecutors: Chen
Ming-Jin, Wu Cong-Yi, Xu Yu-Ru, Ming Ling-Shi, and Zing Shin-Tong, director probation
officer, to the forum. The Daan District Director, the chiefs of village, academic
professionals, residents and more than hundred people from different industries also
attended the forum.

Chief Prosecutor Tsai and District Executive Su Su-Zhen chaired the forum. Chief Prosecutor Tsai's not only declared to her belief that justice is for the people and listen to the people, but also accessed to Taipei District Prosecutors Office through internet to introduce how to service the people, how to access those services, and how to reflect the opinions learnt from the people. Meanwhile the members from the Legal Aid Foundation Taipei Branch were also invited to propagate their work of leagal aid and educate the public how to use those legal aid resources. Most attendants felt that they learnt a lot from the forum.

Many chiefs of village asked in the forum whether they were applied for the definition of "civil servants" defined in the Anti-Corruption Act. Residents insisted that the notorious phone fraud gang shall be strictly punished.

Chief Prosecutor Tsai explained the related laws and decrees; she also expressed the government's determination to fight corruption and fraud gang. She invited the Director of Daan Precinct, Taipei City Police Department to publicize how to prevent fraud and search for related information. The forum ended with a highly engaged and enthusiastic interactions.
