Taipei District Prosecutors Office 2022 Judicial Volunteer Training Event and Thanksgiving Tea Party for Appreciating the Old and Welcome the New

Taipei District Prosecutors Office has strengthened its service to the people. Recently, it has recruited judicial volunteers with the spirit of public service. A total of 10 new volunteers have been recruited. They will join the ranks of service from January 2012. In order to improve the professional knowledge of the newly appointed judicial volunteers and to appreciate the current volunteers for their contributions to the Office, the "2022 Judicial Volunteer Training Activity and Gratitude Tea Party for Appreciating the Old and Welcome the New" will be held this afternoon (28th).

At the meeting, Chief Prosecutor Lin presented each volunteer with the 2022 souvenir " Scale of Taipei District Prosecutors Office " hourglass, symbolizing the blessing and implication of cherishing time, and hoped that the participants could share the spirit of "objectivity, independence, fairness and justice" upheld by Taipei District Prosecutors Office. It is manifested in various businesses serving the people. In addition to affirming the long-term dedication of current judicial volunteers, the Chief Prosecutor Lin also welcomed new volunteers to join, and hoped that everyone will work together to practice people-oriented, flexible and warm judicial services. A total of 30 judicial volunteers participated in the tea party. Firstly, the director of the Litigation Counseling Section led the new volunteers to learn about the environment of the Office's internal negotiation field, and then arranged for colleagues from the Litigation Counseling Section and the Ethics Official to conduct business promotion and share their personal experiences. The anecdotes and experience talks of colleagues serving the people on the front line of the Office let volunteers understand the relevant business processes in the Office, and also promoted exchanges among volunteers.

Feeling that judicial volunteers come from all walks of life and are dedicated to serving the people with enthusiasm, Taipei District Prosecutors Office planed to rely on their talents. Since January 2023, a "Judicial Volunteer Legal Service Area" has been added, and retired judicial seniors will provide legal consulting services, it is expected to be held once a week at the Civil Service Center on the 1st floor to help the public understand the general legal process and strengthen the protection of rights and interests. The public is welcome to make more use of it.
