The TDPO STRONGLY CONDEMNS VIOLENT INTIMIDATION ACTS: IMMEDIATE AND STRICT LEGAL ACTION VOWED AGAINST INDIVIDUALS WHO POSTED BLOOD-STAINED PHOTOS AND "LIFE-FOR-A-LIFE" THREATS AGAINST PROSECUTORS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL

Regarding the incident on July 2, where unscrupulous individuals posted photos of the TDPO prosecution team handling the Core Pacific City Shopping Center (京華城) case on a certain social media platform, overlaying them with bloodstain markings and issuing violent threats like "life for a life" and "owe a life," these actions constitute criminal offenses involving violent intimidation of law enforcement personnel.

In addition to strongly condemning these unlawful acts, the TDPO has directed the Criminal Investigation Division of the Taipei City Police Department to immediately and thoroughly investigate the matter in strict accordance with the law. This swift action is necessary to ensure the personal safety of prosecutors, judges, and all law enforcement personnel, and to safeguard the integrity of judicial investigation and trial processes.

The TDPO calls upon all sectors of society to respect the judicial trial process. Parties involved in individual cases should return their claims and contentions to the criminal procedure, conduct their attacks and defenses lawfully, and allow the court to weigh the evidence and determine the merits of the case. We urge all parties not to attempt to interfere with judicial proceedings through unlawful means such as violent intimidation, thus preserving a pure space for independent judicial review.
