To guard against terrorist attacks and enhance emergency communication mechanisms, in accordance with the instructions from the Taiwan High Prosecutors Office, Taipei District Prosecutors Office establish a “Counter-Terrorism Response Team” to investigate cases involving offenses against public safety in a unified manner to safeguard public security.

- I. In accordance with the instructions from the Taiwan High Prosecutors Office, Taipei District Prosecutors Office establish a “Counter-Terrorism Response Team” on December 22, 2025. With the director of National Security Division, Lee, Chung-Jen as a convener, the team is composed of six prosecutors, Hsu, Chih-Ping, Lee, Ming-Che, Yang, Shu-Wen, Kao, Chao-Yu, Liu, Hsing-Ju, and Lee, An-Er. The team adopts team-based investigation manner to handle cases involving intimidation and offenses against public safety in cyber networks, mass transportation systems, or public places.
- II. The Taipei District Prosecutors Office has established vertical and horizontal liaison channels with Taipei City Police Department, New Taipei City Police Department, Taipei City Field Office, Ministry of Justice Investigation Bureau and Taipei Military Police Corps. This

network implements a response mechanism encompassing proactive monitoring, reporting, intervention and public outreach. It also enhance investigative actions and expand the investigation by tracing the sources in order to deter the expansion of intimidation, copycat behaviors and the spreading of fear.

- III. The Taipei District Prosecutors Office reiterates that any acts attempting to disrupt social order, spread fear, or endanger public safety through violence or intimidation will be rigorously investigated and prosecuted in accordance with the law; no leniency will be granted. In addition, the Taipei District Prosecutors Office urges the public to remain calm, not to spread or forward unverified messages to others, and work together to safeguard social stability and the safety of all citizens.
